Important Notice Regarding UKHTC-2021, April 4-6, 2022

- The conference will be held in early April in **on-line mode only** using the '**Gather Town**' **Conference Platform**. Guidance on Gather Town (<https://gather.town>) will be offered in March to allow participants to make optimum use of this acclaimed software platform.)
- **NB: The conference has been extended to April 6th to give presenters sufficient time to report their discoveries. (But there will be no pre-conference reception on April 3rd)**
- **More than 130 papers and 7 keynote lectures from international experts will be presented plus possible on-line interactions with sponsors, industrial contributors and journal editors.**
- **Registration will open from early February, 2022.**
- The shift to on-line mode has enabled a substantial reduction in registration fees. '**Early Bird**' fees are: **Regular £220. ; Student £170.**
- **To qualify for 'Early Bird' status, registration must be completed by Thursday, March 10th.**
- All later registrations must be completed by 12.00 noon on Monday March 28th to guarantee full access to Gather Town facilities in time for the conference opening.
- **Each paper to be presented must be linked with a unique registrant.**
