He also serves on the CEN/TC 54 committee for the European pressure vessel standard EN 13445 and is convenor of working group 7 (titanium) and a member of working group 53 (design methods). He is a member of the Pressure Systems Group Board at the Institution of Mechanical Engineers. Simon also works with Professor David Nash from the University of Strathclyde, developing and presenting training courses on pressure vessel design.
